After breakfast this morning, you will be taken for sightseeing of some of Kathmandu's most iconic landmarks. Begin at Pashupatinath Temple, a sacred Hindu site on the banks of the Bagmati River, renowned for its pagoda-style architecture, intricate wood carvings, and spiritual rituals. Continue to Boudhanath Stupa, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the largest Buddhist stupas in the world, where colorful prayer flags, monasteries, and the all-seeing eyes of Buddha create a deeply spiritual atmosphere. Next, explore Kathmandu Durbar Square, another UNESCO site celebrated for its exquisite temples, palaces, and courtyards that showcase Nepal's rich artistic and cultural heritage. Finally, visit Swayambhunath (Monkey Temple), perched atop a hill with its majestic stupa, fluttering prayer flags, and panoramic views of the Kathmandu Valley, offering both serenity and insight into centuries of Buddhist tradition. Kathmandu to Pokhara (200 km/7 hour):

The journey from Kathmandu to Pokhara takes travelers through scenic landscapes and cultural highlights. By road, the drive takes about seven hours, with options to enjoy rafting on the Trisuli River or visit the Manakamana Temple via cable car. Alternatively, a domestic flight offers stunning Himalayan views and reduces travel time to just 25–30 minutes. Upon arrival, Pokhara welcomes you with serene lakes, snow-capped peaks, and a relaxed atmosphere. The rest of the day is free for leisure or shopping, followed by dinner and overnight stay in Pokhara.

Day 4 - Welcome to Pokhara

Sunrise from Sarangkot and Pokhara Sightseeing

Today's program starts early in the morning with a drive to Sarangkot for a breathtaking sunrise over the Annapurna Mountain range, including the iconic Machhapuchhre (Fishtail) peak. Apart from its panoramic views, Sarangkot is also popular for adventure activities such as paragliding, hiking, and mountain biking. Later, visit the Bindabasini Temple, a revered Hindu shrine dedicated to Goddess Bindabasini, offering serene ambiance and panoramic views of Pokhara city and the surrounding mountains. Continue to Davis Fall, a spectacular waterfall formed by the rushing waters of the Pardi Khola stream, cascading into a deep gorge and surrounded by lush vegetation and caves. Next, explore the Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave Temple, a sacred limestone cave dedicated to Lord Shiva, where visitors can witness the revered lingam and marvel at the cave's natural formations. Finally, visit the Seti Gorge, where the milky-white Seti River flows mysteriously through caves and tunnels, narrowing to just two meters wide at points while plunging to depths of up to twenty meters.

After breakfast, drive back to Kathmandu via the same highway used on the Pokhara journey, with an approximate travel time of seven hours. Upon arrival, the rest of the day is free for relaxation or shopping in Kathmandu, followed by dinner and overnight stay.

Tax Collection at Source (TCS) at the rate of 5% up to outbound tour of INR 10 lakh and 20% beyond INR 10 lakhs per individual payer per annum will be levied under section 206C(1G)(b) of the Income Tax Act on outbound tour services. The TCS collected will be reflected in the 26AS of the passenger in whose name receipt is raised (Payer/s for the package) for claiming Income Tax credit. Hence the name of the payer & the associated PAN Number on the receipt should be reconfirmed at the time of making the payment for the holiday package booking.

Non-refund of TCS: In the event of cancellation of services and refund of amount, Tax collected at source under section 206C(1G)(b) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 shall not be refunded (TCS applied on the cancellation amount). The non-refunded TCS will be reflected in the 26AS of the passenger in whose name the receipt is raised for claiming Income Tax credit.

In case of no Income Tax Payable against your PAN, you can claim the refund of the TCS amount at the time of filing your IT returns.

Payment Terms

Payments:

All payments towards the tour cost shall be made by the client to the company in accordance with the procedure and time frame mentioned herein below. The contracted, a minimum deposit as given in the table below is to be paid by you to the Company. Such deposit shall hold the booking on confirmation basis and such deposit is non-refundable (forfeited) and interest free, subject to the cancellation policy as mentioned hereinabove. The balance amount shall be paid as per the amounts and the percentages as detailed in the table hereinbelow. In the event of billing errors, the Company reserves the right to re-invoice. You shall pay a sum of Rs.500/- for each instrument in case the cheque dishonoured by the bank. Further, the Company reserves the right to take necessary legal action in respect of the dishonoured cheques, as may be advised.

The tariff of the tour quotation is calculated as per the rates prevailing at the time of quoting it. Total tour tariff should be paid within 30 days before tour departure or due date mentioned in the invoice, whichever is earlier. Interest @ the rate of 12% p.a. on daily basis will be charged on such delayed payment. The Company reserves the right to change the tariff in the event of modification / alteration / change / variation in the said rates before the date of departure. Any such increase in the tour tariff accordingly, must be paid in full by the client before tour departure. Any increase in tour tariff during the tour must be paid in full by the client on tour. All tour tariffs are exclusive of all taxes applicable from time to time. Clients hereby unconditionally accept that the prices, set of services and inclusions may vary on product to product or departure to departure level and the same shall not be considered for any kind of comparison universally. Further, the clients acknowledge and accept that the tour tariff are at the time of publication and are subject to change.

All payments made within 10 days prior to the tour departure date shall have to be paid via Bank Transfer / Demand Draft (no cheques will be accepted) in favour of the Company. For payments exceeding a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) or in the event the value of file exceeds a sum of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs Only) or a sum equivalent to the Foreign currency, a copy of the PAN Card is mandatory for Terms and Conditions.

Payments made in the Indian National Rupee (hereinafter referred to as the "INR") towards the foreign exchange component of Your tour shall be calculated as per the Rate of Exchange (hereinafter referred to as "rate of exchange") prevailing on the day of payment made by You. We are liable to pay to all our suppliers / vendors and bear the overhead costs involved in rendering services to you. If You or any member of your group elect to cancel your booking for any reason, You must intimate the Company in writing on working days within office time. If the Booking Form has been signed / accepted by OTP by one or -more persons for themselves and for others mentioned in the form, communication signed by such signatories would be treated as valid communication for cancellation for all such persons mentioned in the form. The computation of the period of notice of cancellation shall commence only from the time the written request reaches the Company at your booking office on working days within office time. Cancellations are subject to fees and/or forfeiture which vary by your date of booking, your date of cancellation, and by package. You shall be bound by the cancellation charges which shall apply when the cancellation happens on your own accord or due to any circumstances. If circumstances make you cancel the Tour, the cancellation must be intimated to us in writing.
